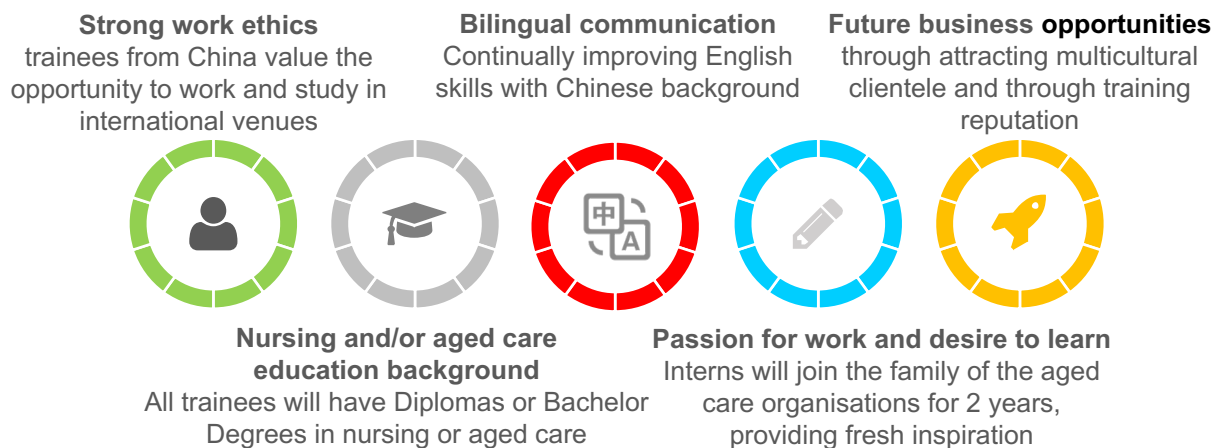
Each trainee spends 2 years rostered in the work environment
